8. Attendance Information

The school attendance was 92.6% for 2022/23. The target for 2023/24 is 93%. Attendance of all pupils is closely monitored.

9. Sporting Aims and Achievements

The school takes part in numerous sporting activities throughout the year including football, rugby, athletics and netball in KS2 as well as Netball Tots, Athletics Tots and Football Tots in Foundation Phase.

The school also takes part in a range of sporting competitions ranging from football, indoor athletics, rugby and netball.

10. Healthy Eating

The Governing Body are instrumental in promoting healthy eating and drinking within the school. School dinners are cooked on the premises and the school cook follows strict guidelines to ensure that they are healthy. Parents who provide their children with packed lunches are asked to make every effort to ensure that they are healthy and adhere to our ethos as a healthy school. We run a fruit tuck shop every morning to ensure that pupils have healthy snacks during break time. Pupils are not allowed to bring unhealthy snacks to school.
