Breakfast Club

Breakfast club is open for all children from Nursery to Year 6 and opens at 8 a.m. each morning. Please ensure you have registered online using the RCT website to allow your child to attend.

School Uniform

We ask for parental co-operation in encouraging children to wear school uniform at all times as it provides a practical and cost-effective alternative to everyday clothing. Uniform is also a badge of belonging and a way of showing pride in our school. Please ensure your child is wearing the correct colour uniform each day.

The school uniform comprises of the following articles of clothing:

- Royal blue sweatshirts, hooded tops and cardigans with the school badge (not required but is an option)
- Yellow polo shirts
- Yellow or blue check summer dresses
- Grey trousers, shorts, pinafore dresses and skirts
- Black leggings or shorts for girls
- White PE polo shirts
- Black PE shorts and leggings/ joggers
- Black shoes

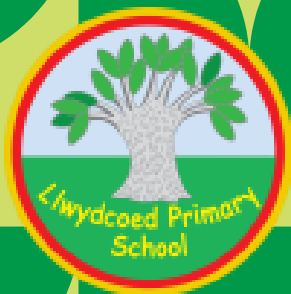
